

Instructions for In-Campus Learning

Dear Highpoint Family:

We are happy to announce that Highpoint Coral Way will open for students whose parents chose for their child to return to in-campus learning. The dates are as follows:

Monday October 5th - Elementary Students to include: Ms. A, Mrs. Diaz, Miss Lauren

Tuesday October 6th - Resource and Middle school to include: Ms. Addy, Ms. Nelly, Ms. G, Ms. Reyes, Mr. Pace.

Occupational and Speech Therapy will also be offering in-campus services. Please contact Javi Lopez and Ana Mari Weiss to schedule your child's therapy.

At this time, we are not accepting more students for in-campus learning for the remainder of this quarter. Students who wish to switch from virtual to in-campus learning may do so for the beginning of the 2nd quarter on **Monday November 2nd**. You will need to submit your request online.

Guidelines:

- ✎ Before Care: 8:00 – 8:30 (We will not admit students into the building before 8:00 am).
- ✎ After Care: 3:00 – 5:30 pm
 - Elementary Students must enter through the side entrance to the Primary Building.
 - Middle School and Resource students must enter through the main entrance.
- ✎ Students must enter the building wearing a mask. They will be given a lanyard with their name on it to clip their mask. Lanyard will remain at school. Students will remain socially distanced inside the classroom at all times.
- ✎ Prior to entering the campus, student temperature will be taken and recorded with a touch-free digital thermometer. Students will be required to sanitize their hands. Students with flu-like symptoms or a temperature of 100.4 will not be allowed entry to the school.

- ✎ Safe zones have been created throughout the outdoor areas in which students will be allowed to remove their mask while maintaining social distancing. "Safe Zone" Breaks will be provided throughout the day.
- ✎ **LUNCH: UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, PIZZA FRIDAY AND SCHOOL CATERED LUNCH WILL BE DISCONTINUED.** Students must bring lunch and snacks from home in a disposable bag. Microwave oven use is prohibited.
- ✎ Students may remove their masks for lunch. They will sit 3 per table behind Acrylic partitions.
- ✎ Students must bring water bottles from home. All water fountains at school have been retrofitted as a water dispensing station.
- ✎ Students will need to bring a Tablet/Device with wifi connectivity labeled with their name to use during "Computer Time". They will only be allowed to go on Khan Academy and other Academic sites as required by their teacher. Students who do not have a device may use this time to complete HW or will be given an assignment. During Computer time, students will sit socially distanced in the lunchroom area behind acrylic partitions.
- ✎ Parents or visitors are not allowed in the building. If a parent needs to drop off any items, you must drop it off in the front lobby.

Classes will be offered simultaneously for in-campus and virtual learning. This will be an adjustment period for all and our teachers will be doing their best to provide a quality education for every student. We ask our families to be patient and understanding as we adapt to this new method of teaching.
