1. "Bunnicula" by Deborah and James Howe

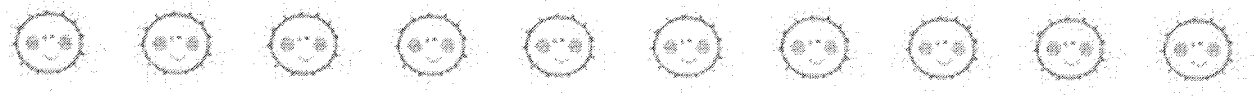
Attached are questions and vocabulary review with an accompanying book review..
